What is in the works?

Squirrel Season Long: the original wax will soon be finished. I hope to have it cast in very limited numbers in June or July. Reserve your order early and select your patina, red or black & tan.

<u>Dreaming of Tomatoes MS</u> (mini-smooth) is my next project. The clay will be finished before I go to Colorado this early summer! It will be in bronze by this fall at the latest.

<u>Siesta MS</u> (mini-smooth), and <u>Sweet Roll MS</u> will be my next projects, followed by the male <u>Squirrel Season Smooth MS</u>. When my suppliers see the size and I know the price of bronze, I will be able to better present a price on these pieces.

Don't be too surprised if I throw in another piece or so; I have to make new work for my soul.

I will also chase waxes, and complete <u>Sunnyside</u> <u>Up</u> 1:6 scale, for Christmas 2007.
